

## Addendum to WACFA By Laws - Mens Competition for 2023

## 17/07/2023

This document is to be read in conjunction with the rules and regulations as stated in WACFA By Laws except the following will take precedent where there is a conflict between the two documents.

## **Competition Format**

Phase 1:

One league division of 11 teams.

This phase will consist of a fixture of 11 weeks of home and away league matches played over a "round robin" format generated by "Squadi" (Football West Fixtures Software). Each team will have at least 5 games of home games, however as there are 11 weeks of competition some teams will have 6 home games.

At the completion of this phase, the top 6 teams in the division will move to a "Premier League" and the 5 bottom teams to "Division One".

Phase 2:

Two divisions: "Premier League"- 6 teams

"Division One" - 5 teams

Teams in each division will carry the points and related statistics through form Phase 1 of the competition.

**Premier League** will consist of a fixture of 7 weeks of home and away league matches played over a "round robin" format generated by "Squadi" (Football West Fixtures Software). At the completion of the league rounds, the top four teams in each league will compete in their respective final series. 1st place in the league table to play 4th place and 2nd place to play 3rd place in the semi-finals. Losers of the semi-finals games are eliminated and winners progress to the grand final. Winning team of the grand final will be awarded Cup Winners and the loser Runners- Up.

**Division 1** will consist of a fixture of 5 weeks of home and away league matches played over a "round robin" format generated by "Squadi" (Football West Fixtures Software). At the completion of the league rounds the finals series will be run over the last 3 weeks. The top four teams in the league at completion of the fixtures will compete in the final series. 1<sup>st</sup> place in the league table to play 2<sup>rd</sup> place in a qualifying final and 3<sup>rd</sup> place to play 4<sup>th</sup> place an elimination-final in the first week. Loser of the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> placed team elimination final game will be eliminated. Loser of the 1<sup>st</sup> place and 2<sup>nd</sup> place qualifying final will play the winner from the elimination final in the second week. Winner of the game form the second week will play the winner of the qualifying final from week 1 in the grand final on week 3. Winning team of the grand final will be awarded Cup Winners and the loser Runners- Up.

There will also be league winners and runner -up awards for each of the divisions based on final standings in their respective league tables at the completion of the 18 weeks of the season.
